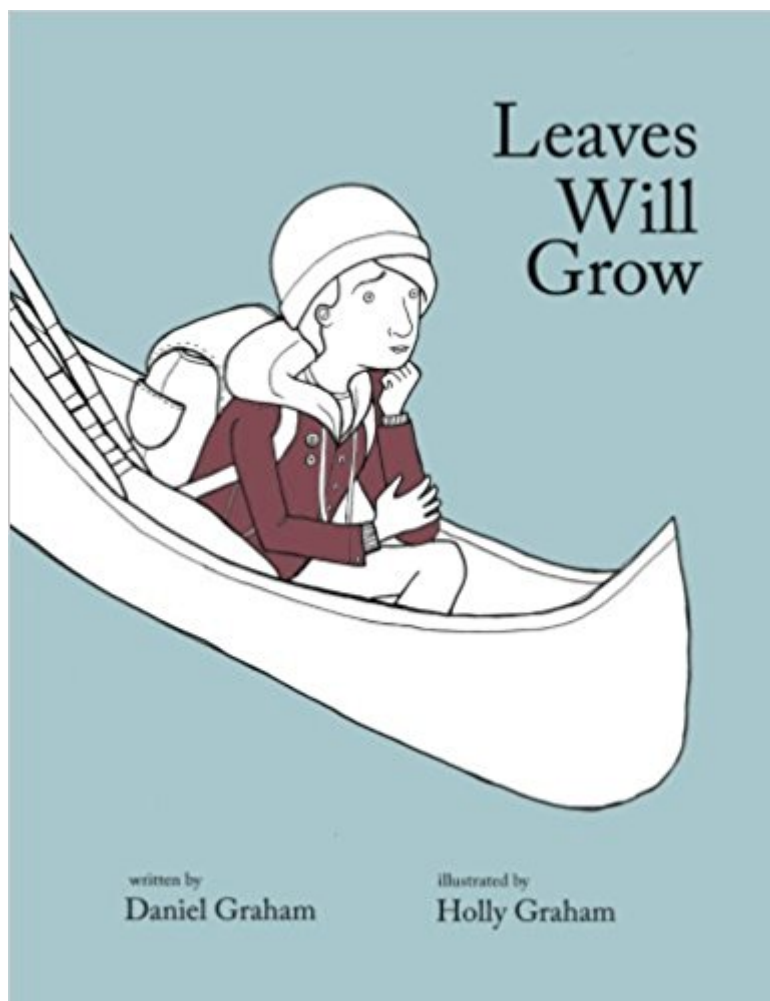

This is a story that you will want to read over and over again, because all ages can relate to it. Full of poetry, imagery and symbolism, which is beautifully but simply illustrated. Each of us experiences loss with a different perspective but this book allows us to draw from our own life experiences, to fill in between the lines, no matter what our background. I highly recommend you share this book with your child early and often so that loss can also be accepted as growth. I love it!
