

I loved Lawhead's Robin Hood series and this compares very favorably with that. Often I found myself savoring the phrasing and language, re-reading a paragraph because it was so well expressed. Stephen Lawhead is a fabulous author, a joy to read. His words paint a vivid picture in your mind. His talent is so amazing that he can describe in a few sentences, what other writers can't convey in pages. I was very moved by his description of faith in "the one God". This book continues the adventures of many of the characters from "In the Hall of the Dragon King" but the challenges they face are completely separate. I did enjoy this book a little more than the aforementioned first book of the series. However, I did still find the dialog too flowery and the characters too hard to connect with on any level.

A most thrilling book to read! The country is overwhelmed by an evil army. It strikes to destroy the great castle. Plenty of exciting battles take place, while a small party attempts to locate the lost mines and find a rare metal to construct a magical sword.

I really enjoyed the spiritual truths gently imparted through the characters as they each faced a challenge and sought the Most High to overcome. I especially enjoyed the section about Inchkeith and the Lanathel. A steady read that doesn't exhaust you but keeps drawing you in.

If you have read previous fantasy books by Steven Lawhead, you know something of his style. This is part of the retelling of the Robin Hood story with many new turns and twists that make it more interesting than ever before. A good read and I recommend it fully.
