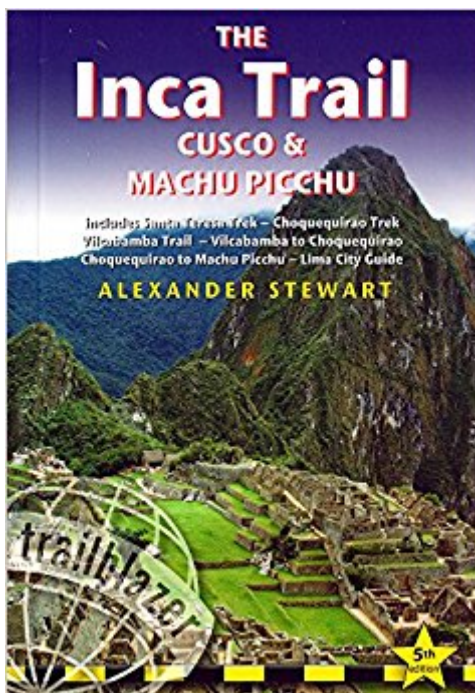

I don't want anybody who is considering hiking any of these trails or going to Machu Picchu to overlook it just because the print is a bit small. It is packed FULL of great information. Great book packed full of really useful information for any trip to the Cusco/Machu Picchu area. So much more than just the Inca trail. Great maps and overviews of each section. I feel much more confident about our trek after reading this book. The ONLY reason I don't give it 5 stars is the small font. I would have given 4.5 stars if it were allowed.
