

Jeff Foxworthy is the largest-selling comedy-recording artist in history, a multiple Grammy Award nominee, and the bestselling author of more than twenty-six books, including his Redneck Dictionaries. He is the host of the Fox television series *Are You Smarter Than a 5th Grader?* Jeff also starred in all three *Blue Collar Comedy Tour* movies, which have sold more than eight million

copies and are some of the highest-rated movies in Comedy Central history. His syndicated weekly radio show, The Foxworthy Countdown, is carried in more than 220 markets across the United States. A Georgia native, Jeff lives with his wife and two daughters in Atlanta.

Being a Southerner, I have heard lots of expressions that are simple. "Grinning like a possum" meaning showing your teeth as you smile is one example. Many of the Foxworthy words and descriptions work easily when spoken, but when read, some have to be thought about. In Texas, for instance, a person can say "Flyer" and it may be flour, flyer, friar, or flower. You have to hear it in context because the four choices sound the same. That's the way some of Foxworthy's words are...you gotta think about 'em.

This is a fun, light read that had me cracking up. You know, in a way it really made me stop and think about the words we use—even in everyday conversation—and not only that but how we say them as well.
