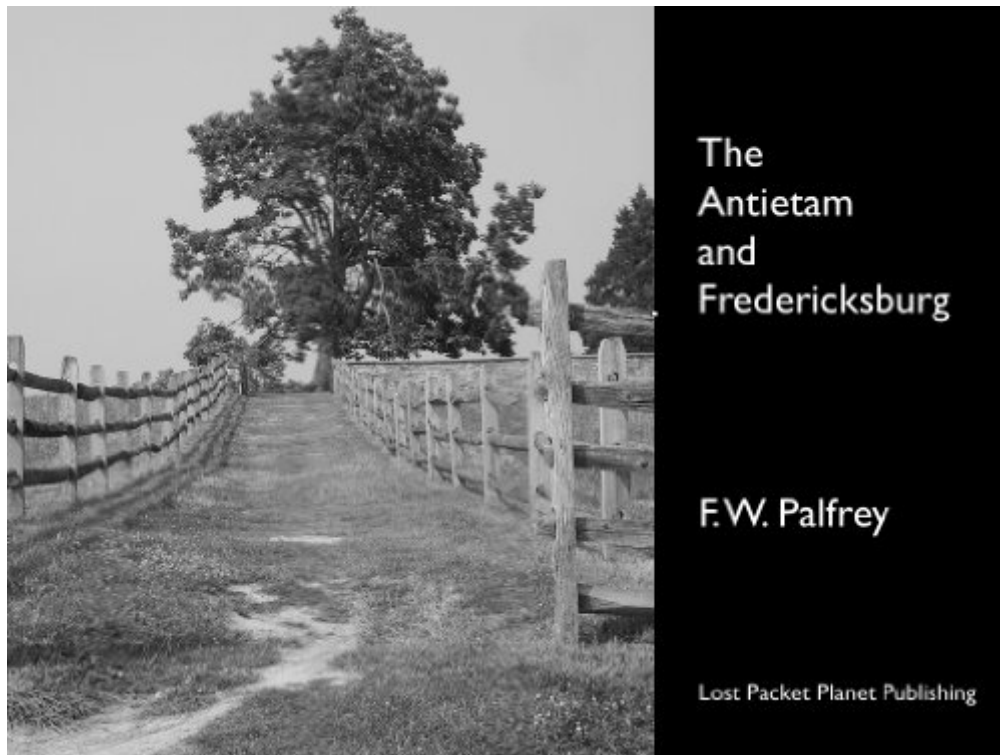


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The Antietam And Fredericksburg (Campaigns Of The Civil War Book 5)



Synopsis

Francis W. Palfrey, Brevet Brigadier (1831-1889) was both a soldier and subsequently a historian. He served at Lt. Col. of the 20th Massachusetts during the Battle of Antietam. He was later a member of the Military Historical Society of Massachusetts and of the Massachusetts Historical Society as well. Here he recounts the campaigns of Antietam and Fredericksburg, from the appointment of McClellan to the general command through the end of the battle of Fredericksburg. Lost Packet Publishing scanned the 1883 edition of this work, using state-of-the-art OCR software, converted the image files to text, added new content about the author and then produced this Kindle version.

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
