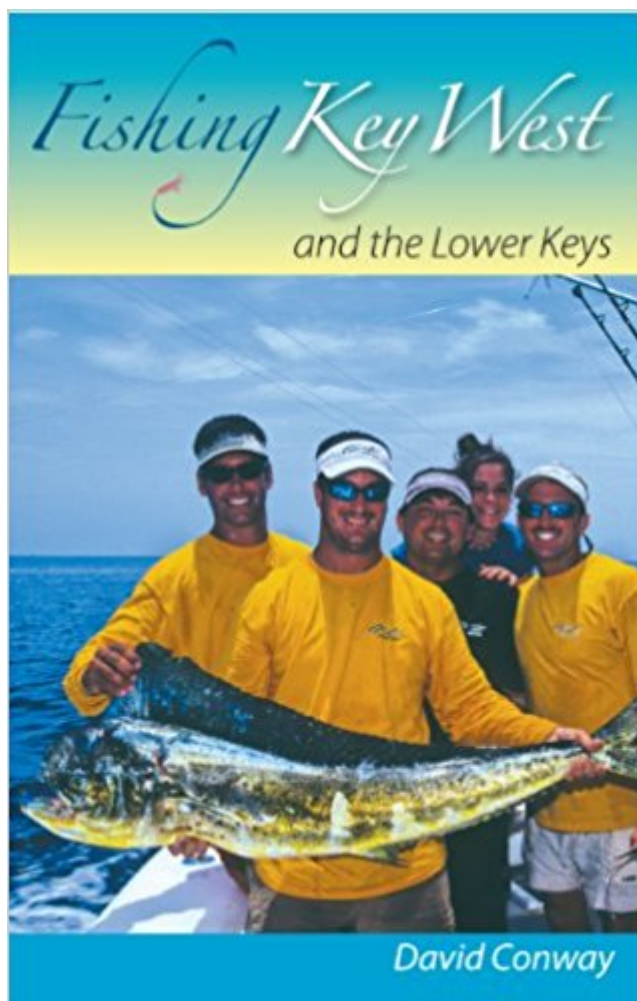

I'm not a local, but have been on several guide trips and have spent probably 50-75 days on the water down there in my own boat (mostly inside the reef) and many things I've discovered through trial and error, guide trips, and browsing hundreds or thousands of forum posts are in this book. It's pretty obvious within the first few pages that the guy knows what he's talking about, and there are quite a few very useful quotes from local guides also.
