

For centuries, Friends have favored posthumously-published journals (autobiographies) as the best way to pass along doctrine and accumulated wisdom. Brinton is one of the great and serious Quaker writers of the 20th century, making him highly qualified to select and edit the contents in this easy-to-read gem. Rather than assemble an anthology of life stories (or pieces of life stories) Brinton walks the reader through a dozen key areas of Quaker life, using voices from the journals to hold a sort of panel discussion on each topic. While most Quaker writers would be unable to make this method work satisfactorily, Brinton succeeds brilliantly. This work is an excellent introduction to Quakerism for any inquirer, and is also an excellent source book for long-time members seeking renewal and increased depth in their spiritual lives.

The dry title of this book is deceiving. Although Brinton thoroughly researched his subject -- the spiritual autobiographies (called journals) of the members of the Religious Society of Friends -- this is not an academic work. It lives up to its subtitle as an exploration of the religious experiences of Friends through their own words with engaging anecdotes and excerpts as well as insightful comments. These ordinary people spoke movingly and charmingly about their spiritual lives. I not

only bought this book but sought out two of the original journals to read.
