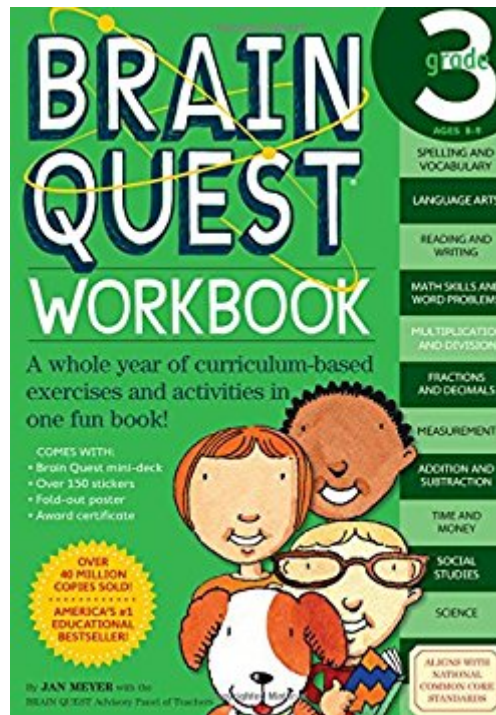

The directions at the top of the page are easy to understand and my son can complete pages on his own. My son loves math and this workbook seems heaviest on math subjects.
