

This one was a bit more tedious for me to read because it was focused on a lot of politics going on in London and the war with Napoleon. We already know how it turned out, so it was kind of boring for me.

As part of the Poldark series by Winston Graham it provides deeper character development of the four women intrinsic to the entire story. It's very well written, moves along smoothly and gives the reader valuable information.

I got hooked on the Poldark series from 2 seasons on PBS. Couldn't wait for season 3 so began reading the books. All 12 of them. Love the story, fantastic writing, each book has unexpected twists and turns, never boring.
