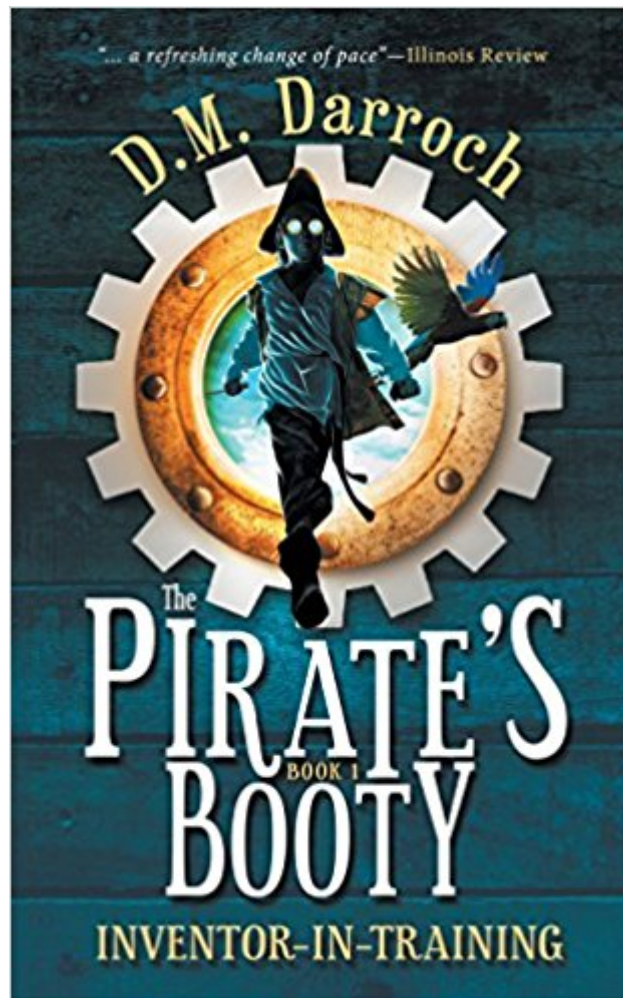




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The Pirate's Booty (Inventor-in-Training) (Volume 1)

I came up with this idea when I told my son bedtime stories. One of my son's favorite characters was an unlucky pirate captain who was forever losing his ship. Sometimes he was attacked by other pirates, sometimes he slipped on the wet deck and fell overboard, sometimes his crew mutinied. One time a spaceship full of aliens ejected him with a laser beam. These stories did not have the intended effect of lulling my son to sleep. He was generally laughing too hard at the misadventures of Pirate Hank. I'm a sucker for kids' laughter. My idea for Angus came from my messy garage. Many parents of inventive boys and girls have similar spaces in their homes. During a hike with my son, I had an epiphany. What if a young inventor-in-training like the one who lives in my house were to have an accident and wind up marooned with Pirate Hank? And what if a boy pirate from Hank's ship moved into my house? My son began laughing as I told him the story. I just love that sound.

Mom's Review: Honestly, super clever kids in books tend to be *annoying*. Either someone overestimates how smart kids talk/act/behave, or someone truly understands them but gets caught up in trying to be clever themselves. Not this author! Her main protagonist, Angus, shows all the characteristics of a very smart boy -- while still being just a regular kid in many ways. Any parent with an inquisitive, sometimes exasperating kid will enjoy this book, as will the multitude of kids who can relate to Angus, not to mention Ivy. D.M. Darroch also doesn't fall into the trap of replicating the clever-but-goofy boy with sharp-as-nails female friend (a la Harry Potter and the Heroes of Olympus series). Both Angus and Ivy are unique characters that the reader likes and wants to follow along on the adventure. The whole book is clever, funny, and a quick read. Can't wait to read the sequel! Daughter's (10) Review: I liked how the main character was switched with his pirate self, and how the pirate self has to learn how to act in the 21st century. I also like how the girl in Angus' class (Ivy) is in different forms in the pirate world. It's a really good book and people should read it.

This book is perfect for children ages 7-13 who will find lots of adventure, giggles, and good solid intelligent heroes and their parents who will find plenty of humor and maybe even a bit of themselves and their children in the pages. I look forward to the next one!
