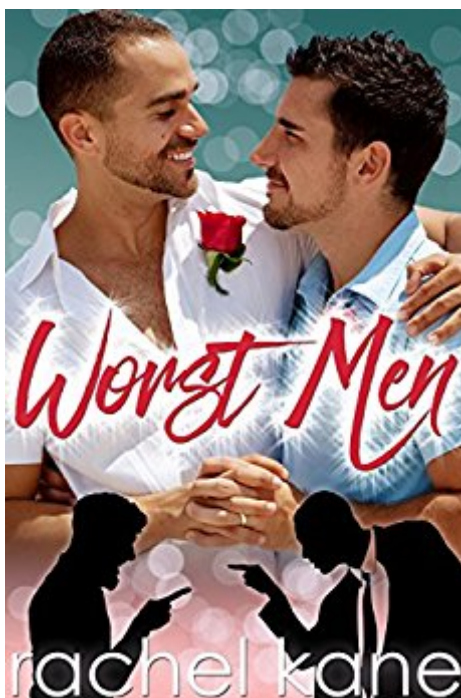

Worst Men is a 58,000-word enemies-to-lovers romance, with high steam, no cheating, and an HEA on a gorgeous tropical island. It takes place in the same world as All For Show, but can be read entirely separately! (Mr. Thurgood, the Boston Terrier from All For Show, also makes an appearance. So does Nat's dad, but the less we say about that the better.)

I received an ARC from the author in exchange for a honest review. Come to a tropical paradise. Expense free for several day. Attend a wedding. What could go wrong? A lot! Especially if you listen to gossip and rumors designed to ruin the lives of others. The only decision you have to make is whether or not you want to continue the pattern or break it. Sergio and Marcus have a painful history but they now have the chance to move forward, together. Just remember, money doesn't solve everything...it can complicate it...

This book follows the love story of Sergio and Marcus. Their best friends Nat and Owen (from All for Show) are getting married on a tropical island. Marcus is Nat's best man and Sergio will gift the newlyweds with an ice sculpture. It is an enemy-to-lovers story at its best. I was hooked from the start and I couldn't put the book down. Sergio and Marcus have some history together and since then they can't be in the same room together without getting at each other's throat. Let alone sharing a hotel room. Rachel Kane shows it is a fine line between love and hate. She describes the changing feelings with perfect accuracy along with all the insecurities and doubts they both have. On the surface, they have nothing in common but deeper down they are more alike than they think. And it is the digging deeper into their psyche that has me loving this book. Rachel Kane has a knack of bringing the characters to life. Sergio came across as a self-absorbed, shallow, rich man but reading on this changes. He is really trying to do better and understand Marcus. Marcus had to do what he did to keep alive but not at all costs. He is stubborn and not looking for a hand-out. They have to look really deep at themselves and at the other to come together. It is a great love story with a lot of pitfalls. Funny and sexy combined with a lot of emotions that come with opening up and learning to trust. The book also shows in grueling detail that there are a lot of people in the world out to get you. Gossip and rumors can be deadly to your self-esteem and your relationship. This is the second book in the series and can be read as a standalone. With "Worst Men" Rachel Kane brings us a kind of a follow up to "All for Show" as we can now read about the wedding of Nat and Owen from the former book. I was very happy to read how they were doing and it was a nice reunion with them and some other characters from "All for Show". The focus in this new book is on Sergio, who we've already met as Harris' Ex, and Marcus, a good friend of Nat. "Worst Men" can easily be read as a standalone, but reading "All for Show" first makes the experience even better and some aspects, like the persona of Harris and his impact on his ex-boyfriends, are better understandable. The atmosphere as well as the general writing style of the two books can not really be compared. "Worst Men" has quite a dose of angst and it hasn't the sometimes quirky humor of the first book. I found it easier to read and the connection to the main characters was immediate and without problems. Don't get me wrong, I really liked "All for Show", but in my opinion the story of Sergio and Marcus was so much better. The two men are very interesting and loveable characters and they really have a great chemistry in and outside the bed. I absolutely loved the development of their relationship from enemies to lovers, although it was sometimes a bit frustrating to witness their behavior and lack of communication. Altogether I really enjoyed reading this book and can easily recommend it to every fan of sweet romances with a touch angst. It felt like the whole story line was based on Marcus' past relationships and their failures. There was too much gossip and nastiness toward Marcus. Then we have Sergio that hates Marcus based on his ex's lies and has hate toward Marcus. I really think this premise was good, from enemies to lovers. I just think it fell short of that. There was too much angst and hate for me. I just never felt the love develop. I received an ARC and read it voluntarily for an honest review.

Enemies to... not enemies? Rumors run rampant from the very start and the two MCs decide whether the fine line between hate and love can dare to be crossed. What is real and who is telling the truth is the big question as Marcus and Sergio try and figure out just what exactly is reality. Time is ticking until Owen and Nat's big day, and the time when everyone will have to leave the island and go back to the real world back home is coming fast. I really enjoyed reading about Sergio and Marcus and how they dealt with the gossip and lies that surround them. We all have those people that rub us the wrong way, but making an effort to move beyond these trials can allow us to build

relationships we never would have gotten to experience. While there was some angst, there were also a few parts that had me laughing out loud. Also, it was nice to see that Nat and Owen are doing well and are moving on to the next phase of their HEA. I love it when an author can loop in past characters while keeping the focus still on the books MCs. Hopefully there will be more books to come. Can't wait to see who is next in line to find their true love! I was given an advanced copy of this story to review.
