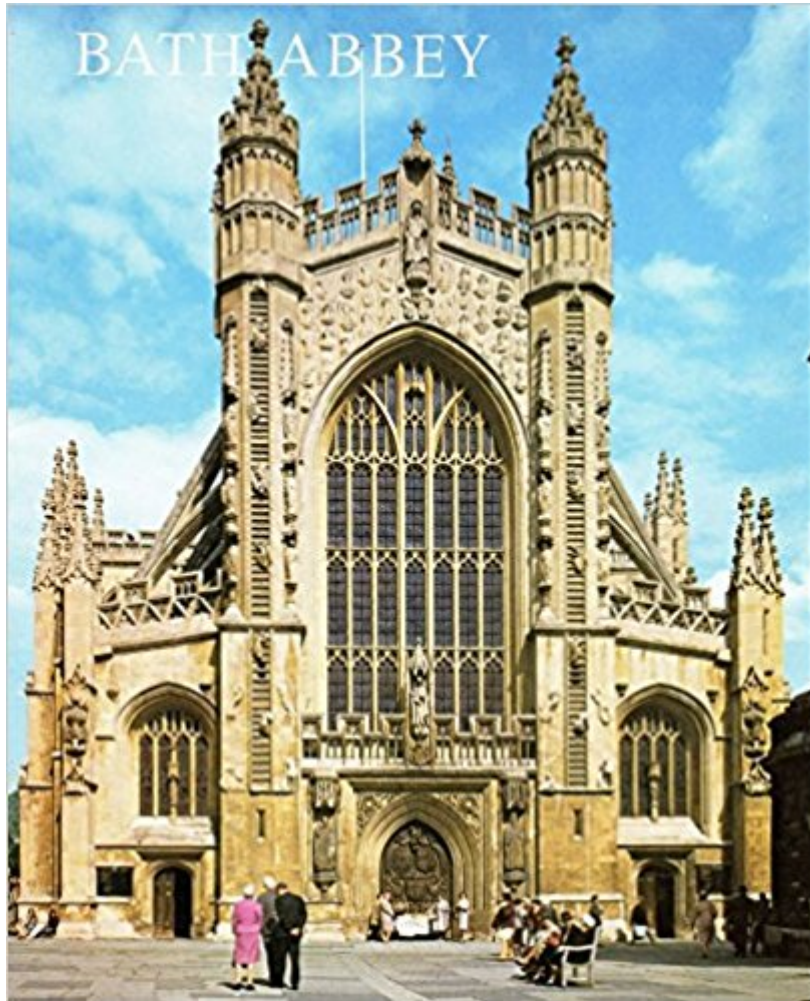

The choir performs in the abbey and elsewhere. There is a heritage museum in the vaults.
