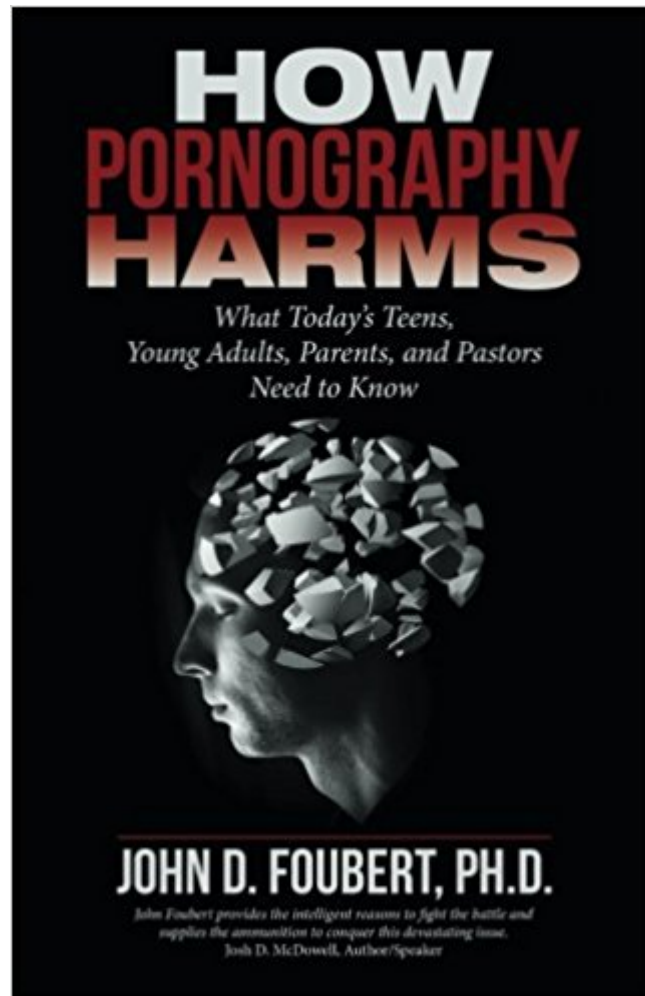

Synopsis

Foubert, Ph.D., an interdisciplinary scholar who has studied sexual violence since 1993, shares the life stories of more than twenty people directly affected by pornography. He also interviews scholars and explains how pornography affects our brains. In examining the many ways pornography is devouring the God-given sexual health of the Internet generation, he highlights its connection to sexual violence and how it ruins lives. He also focuses on who makes pornography and their motives, recent trends in pornography, and how pornography is changing the way people have sex. Perhaps most importantly, he explains what we can do to confront pornography in our own lives, the lives of our loved ones, and in society. Whether you are a teen, young adult, a parent, pastor, scholar, or you are just curious about what pornography does to people, your conscience will be shocked and your points of view deeply challenged by what Foubert has uncovered about the reality of today's pornography.

Dr. Foubert is a Christian but he does not preach, he doesn't quote scripture, nor does he try to 'convert' the reader. This book is based on scientific, factual research, evidence based interviews, which he presents in an logical and easy to read format. He does warn the reader that some parts/chapters are 'hard to take' and may be 'triggering'. He's right there. One might need to put the book down and think about what he said, or put it down to recover emotionally from what he explains. But again, nothing but the facts. The facts of how pornography has literally taken over the thoughts, behaviors, and actions of a whole generation. If you're interested in knowing how pornography harms, then *How Pornography Harms* is a must read.

Dr. Foubert shows the unflattering side of the effects of pornography. The one statistic that scared me was the causation (not correlation) link between those that subconsciously need visual stimulation through pornography to facilitate an erection. That means if I habitually use porn, I could

be at a high risk of erectile dysfunction!! If I were the porn industry, I'd be working very hard to bury that statistic! Aside from the blatant and obvious harms pornography does to a marriage, brain patterns, and society at large, Dr. Foubert addresses an issue that elicits a tactile response from the reader. This book details how those viewed on our screens (mobile and otherwise) slipped, ever so gracefully, into a lifestyle they now know as harmful and unsafe. This book opens the eyes of the reader so that he/she can no longer dismiss those performing for an audience as anything less than someone's daughter or son. It brings a human element back into an industry designed to remove that exact element that sets us apart. I plan to read this book with my son and call out into the open the things as they are today. It's not a pretty situation and I want to be the one who helps him navigate his way through it. Very well done.

This is a subject matter that will literally affect all of us at some point in our lives, either directly or indirectly. John takes a very unique approach in his stance against the use of pornography. He doesn't just rest on moral arguments. He doesn't just rely on spiritual platitudes.
