Steal Me was a first for me by author Natalia Banks and I can say without a doubt or hesitation that it will not be my last. What a breath of fresh air this story was. Completely different than what I'm used to reading. Kathleen (Kat) Le Fleur is a balloon wielding, party clown business owner with a taste for the dark side. She is just getting out of a relationship with her skeezy ex-boyfriend, Mitchel Jarvis. Jackie Adams is Kat's roommate who works as a phone sex operator. She convinces Kat to let go of her inhibitions and try something new and exciting and introduces her to Longshadows. Longshadows is a highly exclusive, private company that will make your wildest, dirtiest, innermost darkest fantasy become a reality, for a hefty price, that is. They have a strict non-disclosure agreement to include a policy that no names are exchanged between the client and actor hired to fulfill the fantasy. Carter Fields works for Longshadows and he has a very dark side. He's hired to make Kat's fantasy come true. What starts out as a fantasy quickly turns into a reality when Kat and Carter's feelings towards each other become known and begin to interfere with Longshadows strict policies. Policies broken won't be tolerated by Longshadows owner, Tia McBride or her sidekick Shin Lu who has a penchant for violence. What happens if they give in to their desires outside of the fantasy? It's a run for their lives once it becomes clear that their secret is out. What will become of Kat and Carter? I'm not telling, but relationships of all kinds will be tested. Their lives take a dramatic turn and danger lurks around every single corner and they don't know who to trust. It's a who's who of questionable characters. You will be dangling on the edge of your seat from all the suspense, trying to figure out who the bad guys are. This book has a smorgasbord of shady people. Including Mitchel her ex, Ben, Kat's business partner, Carter's unscrupulous family members Austin, Meadow, Houston & AJ. I really wanted to throat punch them all. I loved to hate them. This book is filled with twists, turns and surprises you won't see coming. I loved the way the fantasy scenes were written. So explicit, sensual, sexy, spicy and suspenseful and scary at times. At 29yo she's feeling dissatisfied, antsy and just knows something needs to change. Her BFF Jackie arranges a new experience through Longshadows, an ADULT entertainment company specializing in kidnapping-for-hire. Kat gets thrown into the deep end when she meets Carter, her kidnapper and sexual guru. This story is filled

with lust, love, hatred, jealousy, wealth, selfishness and much more. This is the beginning of a larger story about the Longshadows Company/Academy. It ends with a very satisfying HFN and based on previous books in a series by Ms. Banks, I expect the ones to follow will each end with an HFN for that story. I don't follow the plot but still get the HEA by the last book. I think this was Ms. Banks' best book thus far and HIGHLY recommend it. I volunteered to review an ARC of this book AND just bought the ebook!

Every time I read a novel by Natalia Banks I swear she will never top this one. But she has gone up and over with air to spare with "Steal Me". I was not even looking for the unique hook that the story line takes, and with her masterful character development (as always), Carter and Katherine (Kat), grab you by the throat and pull you along for the wild and wonderful ride that these 150+ pages can deliver. And in the end, you're left with one of the most exhausting/energizing read that I have had in several months. She remains one of my go-to- authors when I've had a particularly rough week or month.
