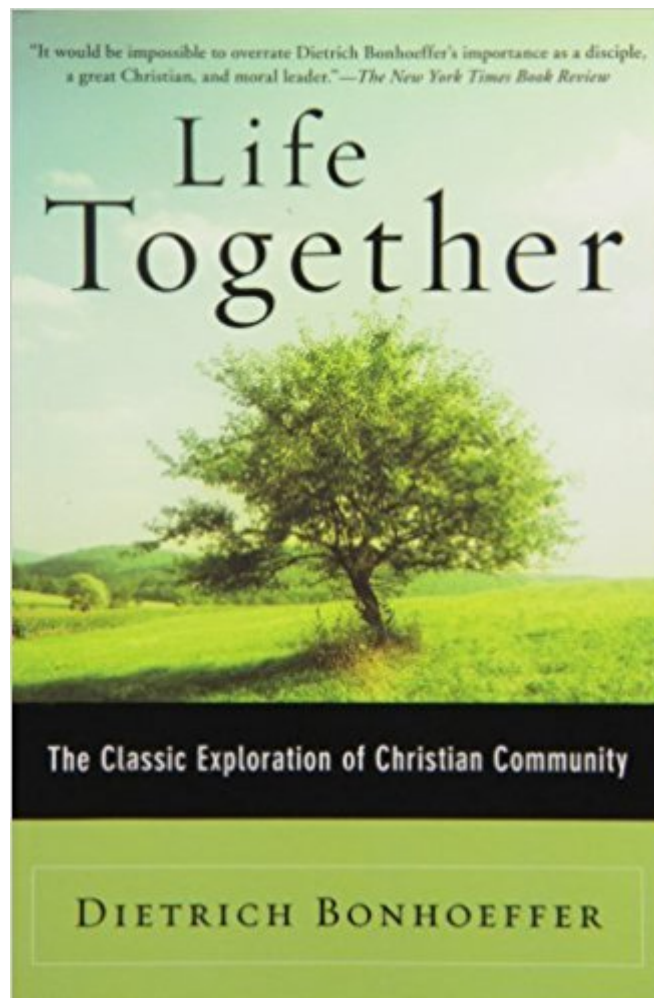

Bonhoeffer's short but concise description of how Christians live and grow together in faith and service is indeed a classic. While the culture and society today is different than when Bonhoeffer wrote, the basics for Christian life together have remained consistent since the time when Jesus schooled the disciples in a similar routine. One needs to understand the time and context for Bonhoeffer's writing and look beyond the non-inclusive gender language. Applicable for personal, home, and congregational life together.

Life Together (1954) by Dietrich Bonhoeffer is a short, densely packed volume of what life and Christian community should look like. This book was published in 1954, nine years after Bonhoeffer was killed by the Nazi regime. In it, however, our series of teachings on living with one another as Christians. He proclaims "Christian community is like the Christian sanctification. It is a gift of God which we cannot claim." One of the things that I really appreciated about this book was how he walks through the rhythms of the day. There's much to aspire to. He calls the Christian to gather in worship in the early morning for hymns, the reading of the word, and prayer. He also talks in a fairly detailed fashion about the importance of the Lord's supper, A sacrament too often ignored in many evangelical churches. I particularly benefited from his chapters on silence and solitude and confession and communion. It seems to me that Bonhoeffer has much to teach us modern-day evangelicals about what the Christian life can or should look like. I would highly recommend this book.

It's unbelievable to read this book and realize that it was written at a completely different time - Bonhoeffer's words are truly timeless and the struggles Christians face in terms of community have persisted up until today. His writing does a great job of challenging your perception of what Christianity community is supposed to look like and what your role is supposed to be. Highly recommend it for a book club since it's a little dense to unpack on your own. I benefited from having time to discuss and extrapolate on points he raised (sometimes in rapid succession).

This could be a little bit of a difficult read, but I got the Audio version and do enjoy listening to it.

There is a LOT packed into every line. Our church has been reading the book together and I can see why. It really does explain why community is important in the Christian life. Bonhoeffer balances Christian community with that of human community which is not for God, but for the sake of man. His teaching put Christ squarely in the center for the Christian.

Bonhoeffer definitely made me reconsider my views upon community and relationships in this work. So often we come to others for our own selfish reasons, although usually unbeknownst to us. There are portions to which you may want to place a characterization upon someone else saying, "Such and such is just like that", but Bonhoeffer has an uncanny way of bringing the spotlight back to the reader without even starting. Then the reader sees himself in that light, and the conviction and admonition becomes clear. At times Bonhoeffer can be wordy and dwell upon something apparently too long, but for the Truth expressed overall and the broadness of his mind, Bonhoeffer's meandering ways can be forgiven. In the end, if you want a book that will challenge your view of community and that will bid you to see all through Christ, give it read.

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
