

The book started out with a jolt, moving on to develop the characters. That's when it began it's slide towards mediocrity. Luke was downright boring. I would imagine violins playing in my imagination as

his character was developed. Ella was interesting in the beginning but in the middle of the story her personality did a 180. She became detestable, killing innocent people, including children. The only enjoyable character came at the end of the story with the introduction of Dan Borowski. For me, I wish I hadn't plowed through it. There will never be enough time to read all of the good books we have to choose from.

I had a problem with the basic setting in this book. It supposedly took place, basically, in London, England. Yet the description of time and place was so generic, it could have taken place anywhere on the globe. I don't recall any English idioms whatsoever in this book.

I only recently discovered Wignall and will be reading more. I hope they all don't focus on hitmen. It was a good read. Obviously, since I read it with only one interruption.

Kevin Wignall has the talent to combine action, suspense, mystery, emotions, and dialogue that grabs you and keeps your interest until the end. There is always a very human side to his characters that somehow is revealed by their words and actions contrary to other writers that just take a shortcut and tell you what their characters are about rather than reveal through their actions. This is the third book I've read by him and he has become one of my favorite authors. Looking forward to seeing the upcoming movie based on this book.

I loved the purity of the characters. There were no convoluted or incomprehensible reasons for their actions.. they knew who they were and were unapologetic about it. Gripping story building and a clean and satisfying ending. I'll definitely seek out this writer again.

Disjointed dialogue, cardboard characters, predictable story line... Don't waste your time.
