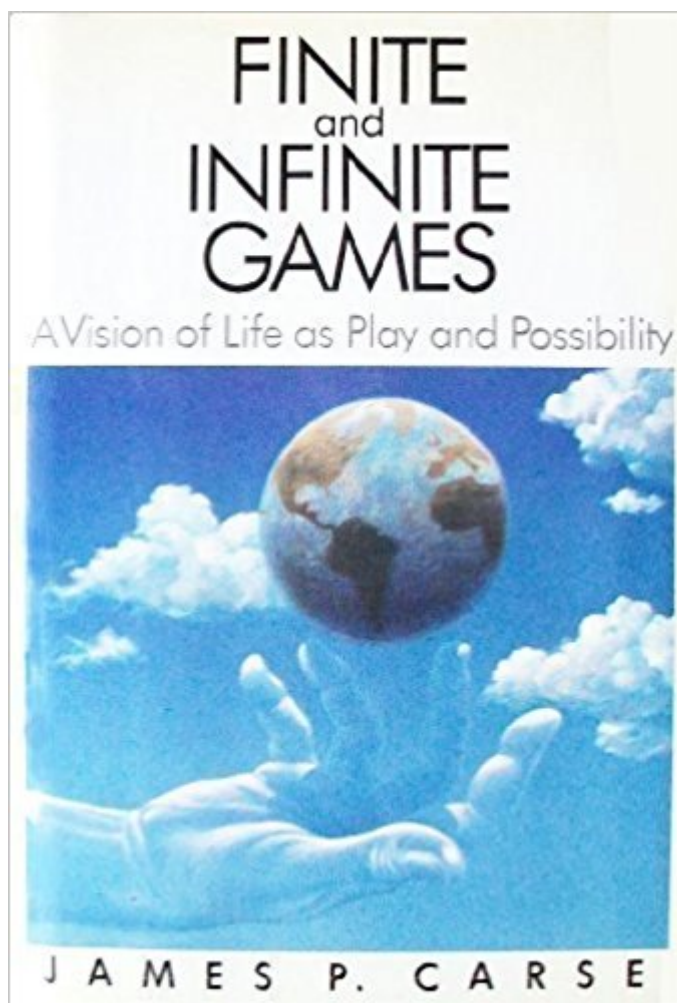

There's nothing ground breaking or new in this book, but I found it to be profound. It made a lasting impact on my perspective; life is infinite play.

This book has had a deep effect on me. I cannot stop thinking about so many of its ideas, such as: the differences between playing 'within' or 'with' boundaries; of meeting someone 'with their limitations' not 'within their limitations'; how sexual lovers can either meet a body or meet the person within the body. This book makes me look towards the horizon.

Its a slog. Lot of dry words for a moderately interesting concept. Needs to be edited to be more concise and pointed.

Excellent read if you TRULY like brain puzzles with a deep meaning! I love it..... but do take time to PAUSE, REWIND, and the re-read from time to time..it will be worth it. You will figure out pretty early on which game YOU prefer..... if you don't then you may need to start with a lighter entry into self awareness reading.
